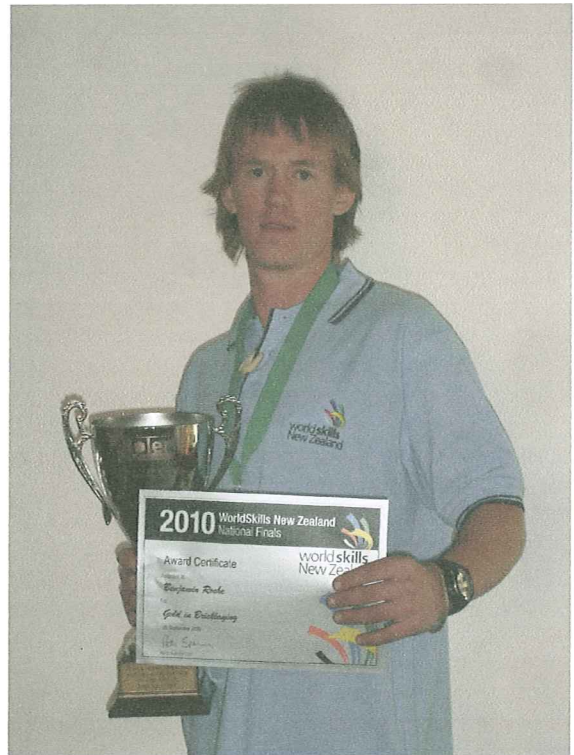


World Skills Bricklaying Competition

World Skills is held every two years, and in 2011 there are 52 countries competing in this International Competition in London from 1-11th October.
