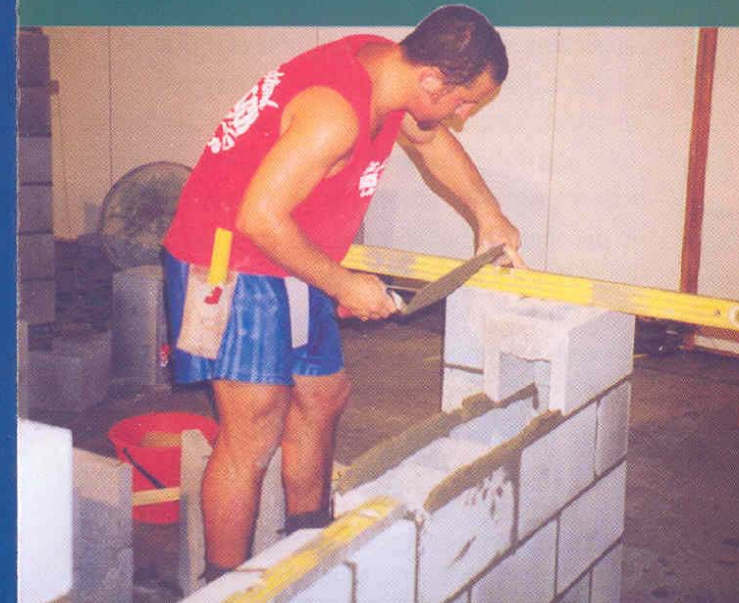

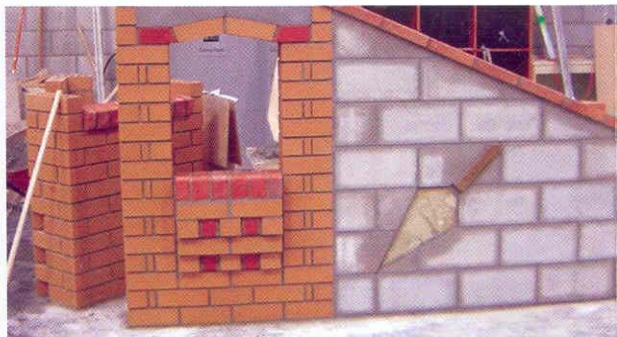

WelTec has been the sole provider of Mason training for the last 20 years in New Zealand and has a wide range of expertise and experience in this field. The new Certificate of Structural Masonry (theory) (Level 4) is designed to provide participants with the theoretical knowledge to achieve registration as a Structural Mason or Master Bricklayer. To complete the registration process applicants will need to finish three practical projects that are supervised by a registered engineer. New Government regulations will require this registration by law (currently 2011 for existing masons and new entrants to the industry). WelTec is the appointed provider of this programme for the New Zealand Masonry Trades Registration Board.

Who is the programme for?

The programme is for all Master Bricklayers and Structural Masons seeking registration as required by law. It is also for people who have been working in the masonry industry for at least nine years but have not had any formal training.

The qualification gained will meet the theoretical part of the requirement enabling the participant to practice as a Registered Structural Mason or Master Bricklayer.



Programme content

The programme involves eight distance learning packages including:

- Concrete blocks
- Bonding
- Concrete and grouting
- Masonry veneers
- Mortar
- Reinforcing steel

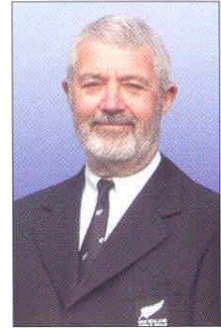
Pre-requisites

Participants must have completed a trade, national certificate or apprenticeship training programme, or a minimum of nine years experience in the masonry industry.
